Transport

Players will be collected from the airport on the Island (Airport Code LPA - <https://www.grancanaria-airport.net>)

Flight information (Confirmation Ticket need to be emailed to bluestareurope@yahoo.com)
There are lots of connecting flights from Mainland Spain and Tenerife at low prices so you may want to check various options for best arrival into Gran Canaria.

Players must arrive on or before Thursday 20th June. If you chose to arrive before Thursday you will have to make your own arrangements for transportation and accommodation.

Pick up times at the airport will be grouped into two hour windows and your meeting point and departure time to the hotel will be confirmed later.

Players travelling without parents please check VISA/Travelling restrictions with your airline and home nation.

Players will be transported to the airport on Sunday for your return flight. We will have a camp activity Sunday morning for those players who have an afternoon departure time, however if you need to take a morning flight to go home that is fine.

Player registration on arrival at the Hotel.

When you arrive at the hotel you will need to locate the Blue Star 30 Meeting room.

Players will need to clear Medical screening and collect their BlueStar30 Camp equipment before checking into their rooms.

Medical information
